TAKE NOTICE that the San Antonio Regional Flood Planning Group as established by the Texas Water Development Board, will hold a public hearing to receive comments on the draft Regional Flood Plan on Thursday, September 15, 2022, at 6:00 PM, in-person at the San Antonio River Authority Board room, located at 201 W. Sheridan St.

In 2019, the Texas State Legislature assigned the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) to administer a new state and regional flood planning process with flood planning regions based on river basins. The purpose of Regional Flood Planning Groups is to provide comprehensive regional flood planning and to carry out the related responsibilities placed on regions by state law. To achieve these goals, Region 12 has developed a Draft Regional Flood Plan (Flood Plan) for submittal to TWDB. The Regional Flood Planning efforts identified and collected locally recommended flood management actions from local government, agencies, regional stakeholders, and members of the public. These include flood mitigation projects (FMPs), flood management evaluations (FMEs), and flood management strategies (FMSs).
